Canopy Zipline



Nauyaca Waterfalls Tour

Naranjo River White Rafting


Experience III and IV class rapids on this river that borders the Manuel Antonio National Park, combining adrenaline and natural beauty.

“El Chorro” White Water Rafting

“El Chorro” offers a class IV whitewater rafting trip on the upper section of the Naranjo River. A 45-minute drive will bring you to the put in point, where after detailed safety instructions and practice time you will begin your adventure.

You need to be in tip top shape for this strenuous yet rewarding journey through a narrow gorge. “El Chorro” loosely translates to “jet gorge”, due to the way the powerful water propels the raft. Children must be at least 16 years old to participate.


